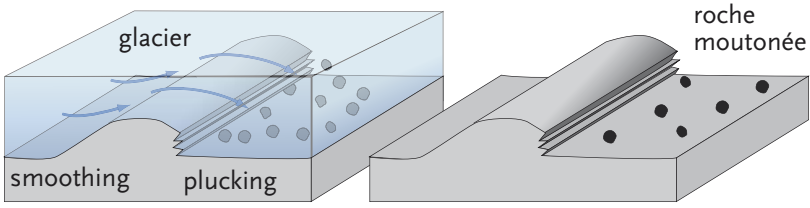


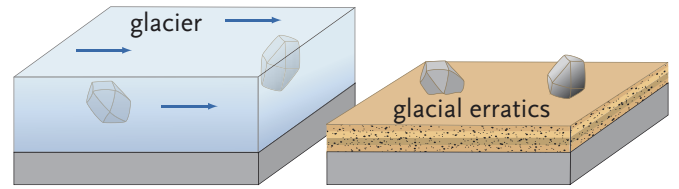
GLACIERS II

ROCHE MOUTONÉE



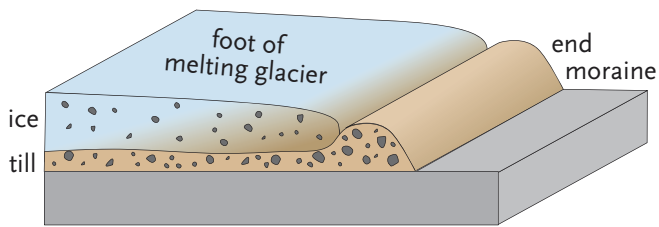
The flowing ice can pluck rocks from the backs of hills. and leave hills with smooth fronts and cliffs on the back

GLACIAL ERRATICS



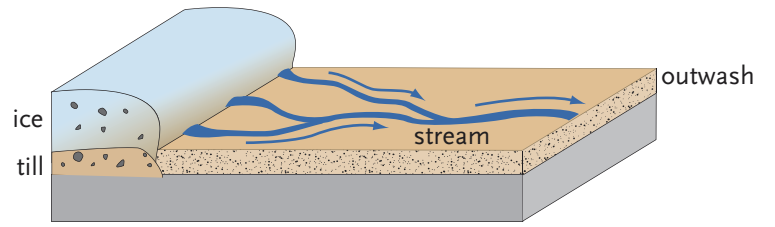
The rocks plucked from hills travel with the ice, and are dropped when the ice melts.

TILL AND MORAINE



Melting glaciers deposit till (dirt mixed with rocks) below them, and moraines (piles of till) on their edges.

OUTWASH



Streams from glaciers deposit outwash (sand and gravel) in front of the glacier
